6. The Chairperson of the Committee stated that a communication from her to Joint Secretary (Administration) regarding request for providing of training to all the employees of MHRD on gender sensitization programmes run by ISTM or any other reputed agency be sent.

7. It was also decided to expedite awareness generation and continuous sensitization for the employees through posters/banners/notices in conspicuous places in the workplace defining sexual harassment and sensitizing about the relevant Act and Rules.

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8. The Chairperson expressed her thanks to all participants.

9. The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
