FOREWORD

On April 1st 2010, the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act 2009 came into effect, giving three years to attain various norms and standards specified in the Act for physical infrastructure and five years for professional qualification of teachers. The 4th year of the RTE Act 2009 publication gives a synoptic view of the progress made by different States and Union Territories viz. the mandatory norms for school infrastructure, teacher availability and other related areas of elementary education.

Since quality of education is the focus of all interventions, for the first time, the detailed findings of National Achievement Survey (NAS) of National Council of Education Research & Training (NCERT) are being included in RTE: 4th year publication for classes 3,5,& 8 State-wise. This will enable us to benchmark and monitor progress of the quality of education being imparted to our students.

It is our endeavour to make public, the status of elementary education with reference to the RTE Act 2009. We hope that State Governments, teachers and the community will leverage this information to collectively take corrective actions for improvement of the delivery of quality education in our country.

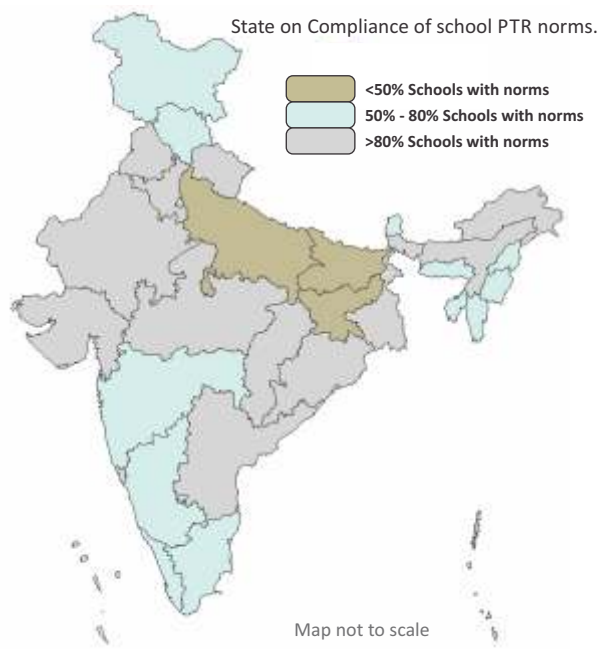

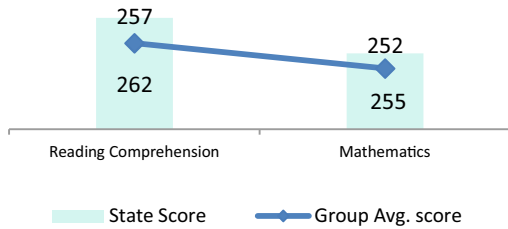

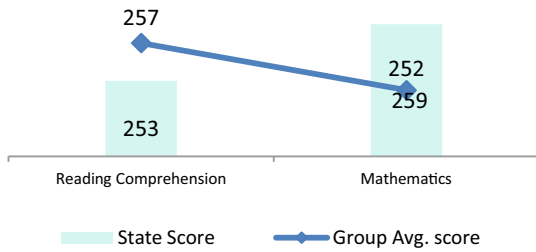

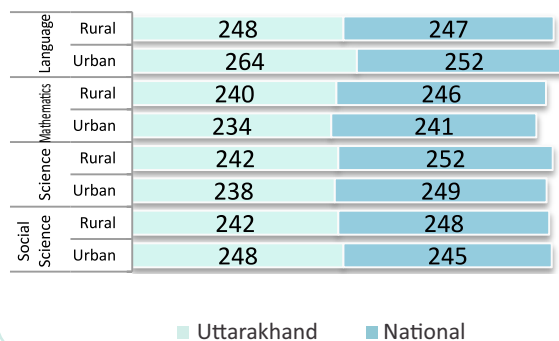
