Subject : State Plan Scheme-Implementation of the Scheme for Providing Quality Education in Madarsas (SPQEM) – Release of Grant in aid for the year 2014-15 to State Government of Madhya Pradesh in respect of Development of Madrasa Board.

I am directed to say that Government of India has approved an expenditure of Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rs. five lakh only) as a recurring grant to State Government of Madhya Pradesh for the Development of Madarsa Board for the year 2014-15 under the Scheme for Providing Quality Education in Madarsas (SPQEM)

2 I am accordingly directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to release a sum of Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rs. five lakh only) as a recurring grant to Commissioner & Secretary, School Education Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh for implementation of the above mentioned scheme for the year 2014-15 and subject to fulfilling of all terms and conditions laid down in the scheme and in terms of this Ministry's letter dated 29.10.2008. This is a purely voluntary scheme and the concerned institution has to apply to the State Government.

3. The expenditure involved is debitable to Demand No.59-Department of School Education and Literacy – Major Head '3601 Grants-in-Aid to State Government 02-Grants for State Plan Scheme, 165-Elementary Education, the Scheme for Providing education to Madrasas/Minorities 01.00.31-Grant-in-aid General (Plan) 2014-15.

4. It is certified that the grant in aid is being released in accordance with the pattern of assistance approved by the Planning Commission and the Ministry as also in conformity with the rules and regulations of the scheme.

5. The amount of the grant is to be utilized only for the purpose for which it was sanctioned. Accounts from the State Government to be furnished to the Central Government within one year issue of the sanction positively along with the monitoring report regarding number of Madrasas receiving assistance, total number of beneficiary students and the amounts received and utilized by the Madrasa.
