



Project Approval Board (PAB) meetings to discuss the Annual Work Plan and Budget (AWP&B) Meeting for the financial year 2023-24 under the scheme of Samagra Shiksha and STARS have been completed for all States/UTs and autonomous bodies. Minutes of the meetings have been issued for all States/UTs. ii. The Supplementary PAB meeting of NCERT (Samagra Shiksha Scheme) for the year 2023-24 was held on 17.05.2023.
2	PM Poshan	Minutes of the PAB- PM POSHAN meeting for all the States / UTs were issued except Mizoram during the month of May, 2023.
3	New India Literacy Programme (NILP)	D.O. letter dated 31.05.2023 from JS(SS-1 & AE) to the Education Secretaries of 7 States namely, Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Telangana and Uttar Pradesh regarding special monitoring of the districts of these States having 10.00 lakh and above non-literates as per 2011 Census.

For Class III & IV (English completed, Maths & Hindi in progress) and for Class V preparation of modules is in progress. ➤ Task No. 85 (NEP Para 4.1 – 4.8) – KVS will prepare action plan aligned with the recommendations as per NCFSE as and when it is published by NCERT. However, KVS has also prepared modules for creating conducive learning environment and continuous professional development of teachers. The same are being used during online/offline mode of training of teachers and school heads. ➤ Task No. 145 (5.2 – 5.7) – KVS has given an advertisement in November-2022 for filling up of 13411 teaching and non-teaching posts in the Employment News in its issue dated 3-9 Dec. 2022. KVS has plan to fill up these vacancies tentatively up to July/August-2023 after conducting written test, skill test (wherever applicable) and interview. ➤ Task No. 146 (5.2 – 5.7) – KVS has given an advertisement in November-2022 for filling up of 13411 teaching and non-teaching posts in the employment news in its issue dated 3rd Dec to 9th Dec. 2022 & 17-23 Dec.2022. The online portal was opened from 5th December, 2022 and closed on 2nd January, 2023. The Computer Based Test for the advertised posts has already been conducted from 7th February, 2023 to 11th March, 2023 at all India basis. The recruitment to the post of Deputy Commissioner & Assistant Commissioner has been completed in the month of April/ May, 2023. The interview for the post of PGTs (12 subjects) and TGTs (09 subjects) has been conducted from 15th May, 2023 to 30th May, 2023 at 09 centre at all India basis. The interview for the post of Principal has been schedule from 26th May, 2023 to 3rd July, 2023 at KVS (Hqrs.). The skill test for the post of Finance Officer, Stenographer grade-2 and Junior Secretariat Assistant has been conducted on 13th May, 2023. The first round of verification of documents of ASO and SSA has been done by KVS on 15th and 16th May, 2023. KVS has plan to fill up these vacancies tentatively in 2023 after conducting written test, skill test (wherever applicable) and interview. ➤ Task No. 149 (NEP Para 5.8 - 5.14) – Modules for capacity building programme for creating conducive learning environment in schools for teacher and school leader have been developed with the help of experts from NIEPA. KVS has also requested CBSE to conduct workshop for Master Trainer in some generic topics for Capacity Building of Teachers.

	<p>Draft Continuous Professional Development (CPD) activities have been prepared based on the guidelines of NCERT.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Task No. 153 (NEP Para 5.15 – 5.16 & 5.17 – 5.19) - KVS has its own Training Policy. In order to align it with the recommendations of NEP-2020 a committee has been constituted including member from NCERT to review the existing KVS Training Policy. KVS Advisory committee of ZIETs meets every year to review the activities and training programmes conducted in previous academic sessions and suggest measures for improvement in the next session(s). ➤ Task No. 178 (NEP Para 6-7 – 6-9) – As per Provisions contained in Para-6.9 of NEP -2020, Balvatika classes(I,II and III) for children of age group 3+, 4+ and 5+ have been started in 49 KVs on pilot basis from 20th October 2022. 5477 children are admitted in Balvatika classes in all 49 KVs during 2022-23. Children enrolled in Balvatika-III in the year 2022-23 are granted automatic promotion to Class I in 2023-24. Fresh admission to Balvatika-I during 2023-24 is being done in all 50 KVs. ➤ Task No. 231 (NEP para 16.1 – 16.8) – Artificial Intelligence introduced as a vocational subject in all 1205 KVs in Class – VIII. KVS conducted courses for skilling out of school/out of education youth in 191 KVs during 2022-23 as per the instructions of MoE and MSDE.

NCTE conducted a 2-Day Orientation/ Capacity Building Workshop on National Mission for Mentoring for selected 60 Mentors on 31st May & 1st June 2023. NMM was a budget mandate of FY-2021 aligned with NEP 2020 and is a flagship programme of NCTE. NCTE launched NMM in 30 centrally owned schools (15 KVS, 10 NVS and 5 CBSE). NCTE has onboarded 60 Mentors selected for NMM to facilitate the mentoring session on the NMM web portal. Chairperson, NCTE launched the NMM web Portal in the inaugural session of the workshop. The NMM Web Portal developed by NCTE will facilitate the implementation of NMM and enable Mentor-Mentee interaction.</p>
National Institute Of Open Schooling (NIOS)	NIOS launched its e-Accreditation portal:- NIOS launched its e-Accreditation portal on May 16 for providing end-to-end solutions for Accreditation. The portal will provide online services such as accreditation, renewal process, de-accreditation, re-accreditation, e-services & synchronization with PCP & Examination.
