2. The following papers/documents are required at the time of interview:
- a) All original certificates/degrees/diplomas, experience certificate and certificate for date of birth or equivalent for verification.
 - b) Three sets of duly filled in New Zealand Commonwealth Scholarship application form along with self-attested copies of all certificates/degrees/diploma, mark sheets, research papers; publication works. Please open the link provided below for the application form:

- c) Ph.D. applicants are required to bring letter of support from supervisor for their proposed Ph.D.
- d) Candidates are required to bring the copy of offer of place (conditional also), if any, from one of the designated universities.



- e) A transcript for all tertiary qualifications and the grading schedule for each qualification.
- f) English version of certificate/degree/diploma which is other than English language.
- g) The original international English proficiency test result, i.e. IELTS or TOFEL or an official statement from the education provider that English is the language of instruction for tertiary education.
- h) Three references (not more than 24 months old) on official letterhead, supporting candidate's application to study in New Zealand. References should be provided from the current employer and a former lecturer and where possible, a relevant government or community based organization.
- i) A 500 words statement describing the specific skills and knowledge expected to gain from the proposed study and its future contribution.
- j) A 500 words statement outlining proposed research/plan.
- k) If employed, a current job description confirming the position and outlining responsibilities and duties.
- l) Employed candidate is required to obtain 'No Objection Certificate' to the effect that he/she will be relieved by his/her employer on selection for the scholarship.

3. Outstation candidates will be paid second class sleeper (Non-AC) ticket fare by Mail/Express train (and/or lower class bus fare where train facilities are not available) by the shortest route from their place of duty/ residence/study in India to New Delhi and back (mentioned as present address in online application). Please keep in view (while arranging return journey ticket) that the interview may continue till late evening. Please bring your Journey Tickets (original ticket of inward-journey and photo-copy of ticket for outward-journey) for TA Claim, failing which you will not be reimbursed Travelling Allowance. The reimbursement of TA would be credited into the candidate's bank account through RTGS. Therefore, Candidates are required to provide bank details for this purpose.

4. It must be noted that the date and time of the interview is fixed and under no circumstances would be altered. It is, therefore, advised to take all necessary precautions to arrive on time.
