

Venue: **Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, Scholarship Division, West Block 1, 2nd Floor, Wing 6, R. K. Puram, Sector 1, New Delhi 110066** (within a kilometer from Hotel Hyatt Regency or opposite of Sewa Bhawan Gate No. 2)

2. The following papers/documents are required at the time of interview:
 - a) All original certificates/degrees/diplomas, experience certificate and certificate for date of birth or equivalent for verification.
 - b) Three sets of duly filled in New Zealand Commonwealth Scholarship application form along with self-attested copies of all certificates/degrees/diploma, mark sheets, research papers, publication works. Please open the link provided below for the application form:

 - c) Candidates are required to bring the copy of **offer of place (condition also)** at one of the universities as given in table D of the application form. It is to be noted that candidate without such offer will not be allowed to appear before selection committee.
 - d) A transcript for all tertiary qualifications and the grading schedule for each qualification.

- e) English version of certificate/degree/diploma which is other than English language.
 - f) The original international English proficiency test result, i.e. IELTS or TOFEL or an official statement from the education provider that English is the language of instruction for tertiary education.
 - g) Three references (not more than 24 months old) on official letterhead, supporting candidate's application to study in New Zealand. References should be provided from the current employer and a former lecturer and where possible, a relevant government or community based organization.
 - h) A 500 words statement describing the specific skills and knowledge expected to gain from the proposed study and its future contribution.
 - i) A 500 words statement outlining proposed research/plan.
 - j) If employed, a current job description confirming the position and outlining responsibilities and duties.
 - k) Employed candidate is required to obtain 'No Objection Certificate' to the effect that he/she will be relieved by his/her employer on selection for the scholarship.
3. Outstation candidates will be paid the cost of second class sleeper (Non AC) train fare, state bus fare (where rail facilities are not available from the place given as present address in the online application or actual travel, whichever is shorter, to Delhi and back). Fare will be admissible by the shortest route and where return tickets are available only the cost of such return tickets will be paid. Travelling Allowance claim form will be provided at the time of interview.
4. It must be noted that the date and time of the interview is fixed and under no circumstances would be altered. It is, therefore, advised to take all necessary precautions to arrive on time.
