



With reference to your application on the subject mentioned above, you are requested to appear for interview before the Selection Committee at 9.30 AM as per schedule attached. The Venue of the interview is indicated below: -

Place: - ***Institute of Secretariat Training and Management (ISTM), Deptt. of Personnel & Training, Administrative Block, JNU Campus (Old), Olof Palme Marg, New Delhi-110067.***

2. You should bring with you for verification the original certificates, degrees/ diplomas, proof of age (Matriculation/Higher Secondary Certificate), experience certificate(s) and any research or other paper that you have published in support of the education/research qualifications as mentioned by you in your application.

3. If applied for Ph.D, you are also required to bring the following:

- i A brief/synopsis of about 500-2000 words about your proposed research programme.
- ii Offer letter for admission from any one institution from UK for 2015 (not for 2014) or any correspondence in this regard.
- iii Supporting statement completed by a potential Supervisor in the UK.

**“Candidates applied for Ph.D must have the above documents to enable them to appear before the interview, failing which they would not be allowed to attend the interview and would not be paid any travelling allowance”.**

4. If employed, you are advised to bring with you a ‘No Objection Certificate’ to the effect that you will be relieved by your employer in the event of your selection.

5. In case of the candidates, who have been awarded grades from their University/ Institute, are required to bring the conversion formula and the marks in the percentage form, **duly certified by the concerned University/ Institute.**

6. TA form will be supplied in the Ministry.

7. **You must submit your application to the Electronic Application System (EAS) on Commonwealth Scholarship Commission in the United Kingdom’s website: <http://bit.ly/cscuk-apply>. The EAS asks each candidate to upload a scanned passport-size photograph, scanned transcript, a**

scanned birth certificate and a scanned copy of any offer letter received from a UK Institution. You are requested to **bring a copy of the filled EAS application at the interview**. Self Attested copies of mark-sheets, degree certificates and age proof should be attached with the application. This should be properly tagged. All supporting documents should be attached with the application.

8. Copy of application should contain the following:-
- A) Photograph (firmly pasted) to the appropriate place on the application form;
  - B) Inside the application form in descending order:
    - i) Plan of study, which should in the case of a research proposal set out clearly the aims and intentions of the study, though this may have later to be modified in the light of negotiation with scholar's supervisor.
    - ii) Photocopy of the reports from three referees (note:- considerable delay is caused when reports from only one or two referees have been submitted with an application).
    - iii) Self attested copy of University or College Records in descending chronological order.
    - iv) Photocopy of N.O.C. from employer (if employed).
    - v) Statement of conversion of Grades into exact percentage of marks, duly certified by the University/ Institute concerned along with conversion formula (If qualified from a University/ Institutes where grades are awarded).

9. **If you fail to bring the requisite documents and papers as required in paras 2,3,4 and 6 above, you will neither be interviewed nor be paid any travelling allowance and other action could also be taken against you.**

10. Candidates should have adequate knowledge of India and the donor country. The candidate's general personality, maturity, general awareness of current events in India/abroad and Indian History as well, shall count towards his/her final selection.

11. Candidates coming from outside Delhi/New Delhi will be paid the cost of the Second Class rail fare by Mail/Express train, lower class bus fare (where rail facilities are not available, from the place given in your mailing address or actual travel, whichever is short, in India to Delhi and back). Fare will be admissible by the shortest route, and where return tickets are available only the cost of such return tickets will be paid. As interview may continue till late evening, please get your return journey ticket arranged keeping this in view.


