4	Sakura Science High School Programme	On 9th December 2023, Secretary, DoSE&L, flagged off 64 children, in a ceremony at CIET-NCERT, who were invited by the Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST) to participate in the Sakura Science High School Programme 2023 from India along with other countries. These meritorious school students are from KVS and NVS of 11 States: Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Punjab, Odisha, Ladakh, Uttar Pradesh and Goa. The group includes 26 boys and 38 girls. To expand the intellectual horizon and develop the spirit of scientific exploration among young learners, the JST in collaboration with the Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSE&L), Ministry of Education, have been implementing the Sakura Science High School Programme under the Sakura Science Programme (SSP) since 2014. The students are invited under the programme for short-term visits to Japan, allowing them to experience Japan's cutting-edge science and technology as well as its culture. So far, 468 students along with 75 supervisors have visited Japan under this programme. The last batch of 57 students visited Japan in July 2023.

		All existing DIETs throughout the country were benchmarked against pre-defined levels of model DIET and the process of physical upgradation of all 613 functional DIETs of the country in a phased manner over a period of 05 years has been initiated to bridge the infrastructural gap. For this purpose, financial assistance of up to Rs 15 Crore/DIET under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Samagra Shiksha will be provided. During the first phase, 125 DIETs of 33 States/UTs have been identified with a total cost of Rs 92,320.18 lakhs.
6	National Credit Framework	In pursuance of this vision of NEP, 2020, a High-Level Committee (HLC) constituted by the Gov. of India has formulated the National Credit Framework (https://www.ugc.gov.in/pdfnews/9028476_Report-of-National-Credit-Framework.pdf) which is a comprehensive credit framework encompassing elementary, school, higher, and vocational education & training, integrating creditization of learning in various dimensions i.e., academics, vocational skills and experiential learning including relevant experience and proficiency/ professional levels acquired. The NCrF lays down a broad framework, enabling provisions and basic guidelines. The concerned authorities will now have to develop detailed operational guidelines for the implementation of the Credit Framework. The NCrF lays down a broad framework, enabling provisions and basic guidelines. The concerned authorities will now have to develop detailed operational guidelines for the implementation of the Credit Framework. CBSE has developed its own SOP for implementing the National Credit Framework (NCrF) in schools through the allocation of credits for classes 9 to 12. The SOP is compatible with the National Curriculum Framework for School Education. All States/UTs have been requested that a SOP for implementation of the National Credit Framework be evolved. Further, a technical platform for the digital storage of credits under the Academic Bank of Credit, as a repository of all credits earned by a student may also be developed and ensure the credibility and authenticity of the credits by utilizing the students' APAAR id.
