What is the Austrian Academy of Continuing Education (wba)?

A new approach to recognising formally, non-formally and informally acquired competences of adult educators based on a curriculum



For what reasons was the wba set up?

- no standardised education for adult educators in Austria
- need to recognise already acquired competences



4 target groups:

educational managers

teachers/trainers

counsellors

librarians

2 different degrees

wba-certificate

Basic degree for all adult educators

wba-diploma specific degree for adult educators











How do students get a wba-certificate?

1. Show what someone has:

Status-Quo-Evalutation

2. Planning how one shall reach one's goal:

wba-advisor provides support

3. Prove of one is captable of:

assessment: 3 days certification workshop



How to obtain a wba-diploma?

- 1. wba-certificate
- 2. Hand in proofs for the wba-diploma
- 3. Compose a thesis
- 4. Colloquium



Which proofs can be handed in?

- formal proofs: degrees, school certificates, ...
- non-formal proofs: certificates of seminars, courses, ...
- informal proofs: papers, theses, seminar concepts, brochures,.....

What are the advantages of the wbadegrees?

- widely acknowledged degree
- already acquired competences are recognised and combined into a degree
- better opportunities on the job market
- exploration of one's own learning biography
- profile as a professional adult educator
