

## **G20 New Delhi Leaders' Declaration**

On September 9, 2023 leaders from G20 members, invited countries and various international organisations met at New Delhi's Bharat Mandapam to adopt the G20 declaration under the Indian Presidency. The declaration outlines the commitments of G20 nations on issues of shared global interests, such as education, economic growth, finance, inclusive growth, sustainable development goals (SDGs), green development, technological transformation and digital public infrastructure, gender equality and empowering all women and girls, countering terrorism and money laundering. It is a significant document which provides a roadmap for a more sustainable, inclusive, and prosperous future for all.

## **EdWG Brochure**



#### **EdWG Report**


