## Important Policy Decisions Taken and Major Achievements During July, 2022

- 1. A three-day Akhil Bharatiya Shiksha Samagam was organised from 7th to 9th July 2022 at Kashi (Varanasi) on implementation of National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) in the field of higher education with the objectives to identify various approaches and methodologies to implement NEP 2020. The Samagam was inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister. Vice Chancellors of Central/State/Deemed/Private Universities, Directors / Heads of Higher Educational Institutions, Principals / Faculties of Colleges, Educationists, Policy-makers etc participated the Samagam.
- 2. An event on the Second Anniversary of National Education Policy, 2020 was held on 29.07.2022. Hon'ble Home and Cooperation Minister launched various new initiatives on the occassion.
- 3. The Union Education Minister released India Rankings 2022 on 15.07.2022. This is the seventh consecutive edition of India Rankings of Higher Educational Institutions(HEIs) in India. During its maiden year of India Rankings 2016, rankings were announced for Universities and for three domain-specific rankings, namely Engineering, Management and Pharmacy institutions. Over the period of seven years, three new categories and five new subject domains were added to bring the total tally to four categories, namely Overall, University, Colleges and Research Institutions and 7 subjects, namely Engineering, Management, Pharmacy, Architecture, Medical, Law and Dental in 2021.
- 4. Capacity Building Commission held a workshop on Annual Capacity Building Plan in the Ministry of Education for senior officials of the Department on 11th July, 2022.
