Minutes of the Meeting held on 12th March, 2015, for approval of Annual Work Plan & Budget 2015-16 of **Maharashtra** under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the Integrated Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA).

The Meeting of the Project Approval Board of the RMSA to consider the Annual Work Plan and Budget 2015-16 under RMSA, including the components of ICT@ Schools, Girls' Hostels, Vocational Education and Inclusive Education for the Disabled at Secondary Stage (IEDSS) for the State of Maharashtra under the Chairpersonship of Ms. Vrinda Sarup, Secretary (School Education & Literacy).

- 2. The list of participants is placed at Annexure-I.
- 3. At the outset Secretary (SE&L) welcomed all the participants. In her opening remarks she appreciated the efforts of the State and the overall progress made under RMSA. While indicating the current spill over of ₹35193.12 lakh under non-recurring civil works, she expressed concern over the general pendency of civil works in the State which significantly curbs the capacity of State to undertake and augment vocationalisation.

Secretary (SE&L) referred to the Swachh Vidyalaya initiative and underlined the need for ensuring completion of all the toilets sanctioned under RMSA, expeditiously. Secretary(SE&L) noted that the construction of toilets approved during special PABs held in November-December, 2014 (to fill in the gaps indicated as per UDISE 2013), and for which the Central Share of non-recurring grant has already been released, has to be completed by the concerned States/UTs by May, 2015. Secretary (SE&L) advised that gaps of toilets, if any, in the govt. secondary schools, based on UDISE 2014, should be included by the States/UTs in their AWP&B proposals for 2015-16.

On interventions focused on quality, Secretary (SE&L) shared with the States the initiative being taken under Rashtriya Aviashkar Abhiyan and the need for States to synergies and enhance their efforts towards impacting the overall quality of Science and Math education in secondary Schools including building capacity of Math and Science teachers.

Secretary (SE&L) also shared about the initiative of 'Kala Utsav', a national event that would build on State's current activities to promote and encourage local Arts and cultural heritage amongst its students. This would be steered by NCERT in coordination with States and a specific line item with funds being earmarked in the current Plan approvals. Detail note on 'Kala Utsav' has already been shared with States separately. (Annexure-VI)

She reiterated the need for States to ensure appointment of secondary school teachers with prescribed (by NCTE) qualifications only, as any gap in this regard is bound to have an adverse impact on the quality of secondary education. She noted that support under RMSA would be conditioned upon State's adherence to these basic norms.

While expressing her concern over quality of inclusion Chairperson stressed the need of the State to pay more attention to availability and support of Special educators, identification of CWSN and focused support to their learning needs.

It was also informed that NUEPA has developed a framework of national School Standards and Evaluation, that aims to bring out key facets of school standards, and its evaluation for further school improvement. Funds are being provisioned for a 3 day orientation workshop of educational administrators both at district and state level, on the framework and its implementation. NUEPA has been requested to develop a module that can be used by the States to conduct the orientation workshop. It is also important that selection of first set of these educational administrators for this workshop is done in a manner so as to ensure that they in turn are able to conduct further sensitization of their teams.

The State was also advised to ensure completion of all the toilet blocks sanctioned under RMSA schools and under strengthening expeditiously. Secretary (SE&L) also stated that the pending construction under strengthening work has to be completed by the State by March, 2016.

Under Vocational Education, the 350 schools were approved against which VE has been implemented only in 60 schools. The State had not finalized the list of schools approved in 2014-15. The State was advised to freeze and share the list of 350 schools (including 60 schools which- were implemented in the year 2014-15) with the direction that no further changes shall be allowed in this regard. Accordingly, the State freezed the list of 350 schools. The proposal for revision of non-recurring approval of ₹2996.00 lakh (2014-15) on account of change of schools and trades was considered by the PAB and the non-recurring approval was revised from ₹2996.00 lakh to ₹4621.30 lakh. Therefore, the excess non-recurring approval for 350 schools for the year 2015-16 under VE is ₹1625.30 lakh (₹4621.30 − ₹2996.00). An amount of Rs.2996.00 lakh approved in the year 2014-15 has been included in the spill over under VE. Revised list of 350 schools is at Annexure-VII.-

Under Girls Hostel, the State has to complete the tendering of 39 girls hostels out of 43 already approved Girls Hostels. The construction works of these 39 hostels is to be completed by June, 2016. The construction of the Girls Hostels, which are under progress, is to be completed by December, 2015.

Under ICT, 7855 schools were approved against which 500 schools have completed 5 year cycle and for the remaining 7355 schools implementation is under progress. PAB further decided to provide 1000 schools under ICT to the State.

Under IEDSS, the sanction of ₹1112.69 lakh for salary of 328 special education teachers for the year 2014-15 in Maharashtra was ratified by the PAB.

The Principal Secretary of the State gave a brief on the initiatives under taken by the State with a view to improve the quality of education at the secondary level. It was informed that State has initiated English Language Initiative for Secondary Schools (ELISS) training program with British Council. This program focuses on pedagogical skills of secondary school teachers in student-centric approaches to teach English and continuing professional development with online resources and action research. The State has signed an MOU with British Council for a period of 4 years starting from 2013 to 2017. Under this programme multiple groups of teachers at

district-level have been formed to universalize the initiatives, and it also involves the active participation on whatsup & facebook. This program is being highly appreciated by the Teachers.

The State has also introduced Video-Based Math Teachers' Training Program (VbT2P) with IIT Bombay which is a technology-based training program of 2-days duration designed to improve the quality of Math training, and is delivered through Video Conferencing tool, A-View & satellite. Under this programme 4,300 teachers have been trained through the Sat com centers & video conferencing.

With onset of NSQF, the State is in the process of revising the curriculum of the existing vocational courses in the secondary and higher secondary schools and making them NSQF compliant. The vocational education has been offered in 60 schools under NSQF. State has finalized to conduct vocational trainings on 6 trades i.e. Healthcare, Auto, Retail, Beauty & Wellness, Sports and Multi-skill Foundation Course (MSFC).

The activity-based Science Learning programme in classroom through Nyaas Trust, which was piloted in 15 schools of Thane district, has enabled teachers to practice NCF, 2005 with a clear understanding of science concepts. It created a pool of teachers who will act as master resource persons. With the help of these trainings, science teachers were able to improve the teaching learning process with more experiments in alignment with the curriculum.

In Maharashtra, Kishori Utkarsh Manch (KUM) is a counselling forum for girls in Govt. schools to improve the gross enrollment ratio of girls in secondary school to 100 percent, to take remedial measures to reduce dropout rate of girls from secondary schools, to develop personality of girls through skill-development and fun activities and to suggest measures to the problems of teenage girls in secondary education, and helping these girls to resolve the problems wherever possible. 1441 schools have been covered under this programme.

Learning Outcomes & ICT Teachers' Training with Accenture has created a set of master trainers who understand and use multiple intelligences and learning styles in imparting training

on classroom practices and improving learning outcomes. It also enabled teachers in self-development activities through online courses. 267 Master trainers, 10,629 teachers in first year; 942 Master trainers and 18,000 teachers in second year have been trained under this programme.

Thereafter, Joint Secretary (SE-1), Ms. Radha S. Chauhan, gave a detailed overview of the status of implementation, planning and monitoring of RMSA in Maharashtra. (Annexure-II). A presentation was also given in the meeting on various aspects of implementation of RMSA scheme in the State including trends in Educational Indicators of the State. It was pointed out that drop out rate of girls has reduced from 10.60 (2013-14) to 9.75 (2014-15), while the retention rate of girls has also reduced from 88.93 (2013-14) to 84.76 (2014-15) which is contradictory. Further, the transition rate of boys from class VIII to IX has increased from 85.79% (2013-14) to 102.64% (2014-15). The State was requested to examine these data and ascertain the reasons for these variations.

- 4. i. The areas of concern highlighted include:-
 - District Nandurbar needs special attention and intervention for GER and NER.
 - District Thane, Raigarh and Pune need special attention for high Dropout rate.
 - District Jalgaon and Ratnagiri need special attention for low GPI.

- ii. In the monitoring reports of Maharashtra, the following points have been observed which needs the attention of the State Government:
 - A bit larger chunk of 743 (5.18%) students out of 14337 have to walk over more than 5 kms to reach their Schools. The reasons may be numerous but need attention.
 - Although all SMDCs are covered by audit, yet the ground reality is that audit has been carried out only in 68 (54.40%) Schools while there is no audit in 57 (45.60%) Schools.
 None of the Schools shared audit report with community.
 - At districts level, all 60 posts against total sanctioned 60 posts, are vacant at SPO level.

- At State level, DPOs level information was not found.
- 5. The Principal Secretary, Education, Maharashtra assured the PAB that State Government is making all out efforts to complete pending civil works by end of the year 2015 & also make effort on the other issues highlights.

- 8. The other components proposed by the State were considered and not approved by the Board (details at Annexure-V).
- 9. The PAB brought the following points to the notice of Secretary (Education), Maharashtra and requested for corrective action:
 - (i) Large backlog of the incomplete Civil Works must be completed and monitored regularly.
 - (ii) State needs to conceptualize and create the necessary facilitative changes to ensure that vocational education component of RMSA in secondary/senior secondary school provides a viable option to students.
 - (iii) Emphasis should be given to quality learning outcomes through timely recruitment of teachers against vacancies, optimal use of teachers training for science and mathematics where linkages with good resource person from higher education institutions should be drawn upon and to facilitate the completion of NAS for class X being conducted by NCERT.

- (iv) The CTEs, SCERTs & DIET must be used for conduct of in service teacher training of secondary school teachers also.
- (v) Maharashtra needs to conceptualize and avail the Module regarding guidance of Adolescence which is available in the website of NCERT.
- (vi) Education Secretary, Maharashtra should regularly review expenditure and release of funds to schools/field under RMSA as well as receipts from Govt. of India and State Govt. to improve fund flows in the programme.
- 10. The release of funds to different schemes will be further guided by the following conditions:
- (i) The State/UT Administration shall give a written commitment for meeting its share of the RMSA, ICT@ school, IEDSS, Girls Hostel & Vocational Education of the budget approved according to prescribed sharing pattern of the schemes.
- (ii) SMDCs or equivalent bodies should be constituted and accounts opened to incur expenditure under school grant, minor repair, civil works, and other such expenditure, which have to be incurred only through these bodies as per RMSA norms.
 - (iii) The State Government will maintain their level of investment in Secondary education as in 2009-10 and give the details of this to GOI before the release of second
 - (iv) The second installment would only be released after (a) the proportionate installment of State/UT share has been released, (b) at least 50% expenditure against available funds has been incurred, (c) utilization certificate has been submitted for funds released in the year 2013-14 and (d) Audit Reports have been submitted for the year 2014-15.

Note for promotion of Performing Arts in Secondary Schools and showcasing as a national annual event – Kala Utsay

"Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Mission recognizes the importance of aesthetics and artistic experiences for secondary level children, especially in view of the role that such experiences can play in creating awareness of India's cultural heritage and its vibrant diversity".

In the context of education of arts (music, theatre, visual arts and dance) and heritage crafts, the Mission is guided by the recommendations of the National Focus Groups on these subjects and the report of the CABE Committee on Culture. The syllabus for arts developed by NCERT should be followed and teachers who have been appropriately trained should be appointed for art education. Art is to be treated as a part of the curriculum and not as an extracurricular activity. As recommended by NCF-2005, art education must become both a tool for the enrichment of learning in all subjects, and also as a subject in its own which is taught in every school up to class X and facilities for the same may be provided in every school." (RMSA Framework)

Performing arts have a key place in this context, especially when there is an attempt to bring together the mind and the body, aesthetically while imbibing and carrying forward the rich and great art forms of this diverse country.

In the six years of RMSA implementation, few States/UTs have been organizing Annual Art and Literary Competitions and Festivals at the School, District and State/UT level. Such an initiative in Kerala (Kalloltasavam), includes promotion of Classical Dance forms of Kuchipuddi, Monhiniattam, kathakali, Bharatnatyam, as well as traditional performing arts like Thiruvathirakali, Oppana, Margamkali, Yakshaganam, Instrumental classical and folk music, etc. In addition, literary activities like Story Writing, Art Competition (Drawing and Painting) are also held, in which outstanding and high quality performances are selected for competing at a higher level, ending with the selection of the best performances at the State/UT level during the week long School Art Festival.

Kala Utsav:

With the objective of encouraging such initiatives across all States/UTs and to promote and showcasing such promising talents at the National stage, an annual event at the National level, Kala Utsav is proposed to be organised. The event shall focus on performing arts – dance, music and theatre.

This event will be the culmination of activities that will begin with schools conducting and identifying talents to represent it at District level, and the District to the State/UT.

The shortlisted schools will represent States/UTs at the National event and exhibit their talent in three main art forms: Dance, Music and Theatre. Since it is a school based activity, focus

and preference will be for **group** presentations, over individual talents. **Implementation**

As part of the RMSA interventions, States/UTs shall be supported (through NCERT), in

- (i) Organizing, and managing activities including competitions at the district and State/UT level
- (ii) Develop, nurture and showcase such talents in Govt. Secondary and Higher Secondary Schools
- (iii) The District/State/UT/National competition may be structured as a performing art festival which include workshops, live performances etc.

KALASHAALASAMMAN

Annual KALA UTSAV to be held preferably in January would entail States/UTs planning their calendar of events accordingly so that they work towards short listing entries to national event by November of every Year. Since this would need continuous support and follow up NCERT would anchor this event as a project under the RMSA, and all funds earmarked for this can be transferred to NCERT for coordination with States/UTs.(similar to National Science Exhibition that NCERT coordinates.)

Each winning State/UT School will be awarded ₹ 5 lakhs for First prize, ₹ 3 Lakhs for Second prize and ₹ 2 lakhs for Third prize. The award categories shall include (i) innovative acts, (ii) endangered / dying art form, (iii) performance by especially abled students among other categories of arts. The prize will also recognize the students and teachers who have demonstrated outstanding achievement in the areas. The national prize shall include a short summer workshop at premier institution under tutelage of leading artist for winning performers in addition to monetary prizes.

At the State/UT level, ₹ One lakh would be allocated to be given away to the Best School in Performing Arts during the year.

The School would decide how to award the students and teacher/s in recognition of their achievement and effort.

Selection

The initial selection shall be made at the District level by a District Committee from amongst the schools selected by the District Committee, on the parameters outlined. The parameters for number of entries at each level, winning entries / eligibility of schools etc. are being worked out by NCERT and shall be shared with the States / UTs shortly.

The State/UT Selection Committee shall scrutinize and shift the recommendations of the District Committee and select the schools from among the selected/recommended schools sent by the Districts for the State/UT level Award and the State/UT entry to the Central Selection

Committee for further consideration for National level Award.

The State/UT Level Committee may consist of the Commissioner/ Director of Education or Commissioner/ Director of Public Instructions as Chairman, Head of SCERT as Member Secretary, and an Expert / Experts as Member/ Members. The Secretary (Secondary Education) will scrutinize the selection and forward the same to Department of Art Education, NCERT, New Delhi.

NCERT, New Delhi, will organize a National Level School Art Festival, which would serve as a forum to show case the short listed entries/ performance and from which the Selection Committee / Jury would then select the winners.

The composition of the Committee will be as follows:

Member Secretary

Financial implication:

State/UT support will be provided as part of Annual Plan proposal and under Quality interventions. Arts & Crafts is an existent item of intervention, where States/UTs have been provided funds for similar activities. This year States/UTs shall be requested to ensure that this is incorporated in their Annual proposals.
