Minutes of the meeting of the Grants in Aid Committee to consider the proposals of State Governments under the 'Scheme for setting up of 6,000 Model Schools at block level as benchmark of excellence' held on 19th August, 2009.

A meeting of the Grants in Aid Committee (GIAC) was held on 19th August, 2009 in the Conference Room of Ministry of HRD to consider the proposals of Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, and Karnataka under the above scheme. A list of participants is **appended**.

2. The proposals from the concerned State governments were considered and the following decisions were taken,

2.1. Chhattisgarh

(i) Government of Chhattisgarh had submitted a proposal to set up 20 Model Schools in as many EBBs. Secretary (Education), Chhattisgarh presented the proposal of the State government. All schools would have 2 sections with classes from VI to XII. Except for 4 schools, 10 acres or more land were available in the remaining cases. For 4 schools, the availability of land was 8 acres or more. School would have 20 class rooms, separate Physics, Chemistry and Biology laboratories, computer room, Mathematics lab., art and craft room, library, medical room etc. He clarified that as per the policy of the State government, the medium of instructions in these schools would be Hindi, but Science and Mathematics would be taught in English. The schools were to be affiliated to Chhattisgarh Board of Secondary Education.

(ii) Teachers would be recruited through a written test and a separate cadre for the Model Schools would be created. The PTR would be around 1:35.

(iii) The projected construction cost for each school was Rs.2.94 crore. Secretary (Education), Chhattisgarh informed that a provision of Rs. 100 crore for secondary education as State share had already been made. The State share for Model School would be made out of this provision.

(iv) GIAC recommended 20 Model Schools in the State with an unit construction cost of Rs.2.94 crore, which included cost for furniture, equipment, playground etc. A list of these blocks, along with districts, is given in **Annexure I**.

2.2 Madhya Pradesh

(i) Principal Secretary (Education), Government of Madhya Pradesh presented the proposal of the State government to set up 33 Model Schools in as many EBBs. She clarified that adequate land (minimum of 5 acre) was available in each case. All schools would have classes from VI to XII with 2 sections in each class. She stated that as per the policy of the State government, the medium of instructions in these schools would be in Hindi. However, Science and Mathematics would be taught in English.

(ii) It was observed that the State government was yet to develop a lay out plan for the Model Schools. They were advised to quickly develop an indicative building plan based on the broad KV norms which are available on the website of the MHRD. This plan might be modified and improved upon to suit local conditions and innovative features incorporated through measures like design contest. However, there was a need to furnish an indicative basic plan quickly to MHRD.

(iii) GIAC recommended 33 schools in the State with the admissible unit cost being Rs.3.02 crore per school. A list of these blocks, along with districts, is given in **Annexure II**.

2.3 Karnataka

(i) Commissioner, Public Instructions, Government of Karnataka submitted the clarifications requested from them with regard to their initial proposal. In view of the clarifications, GIAC decided to take up their proposal.

(ii) It was observed that land had been identified in each case. In a majority of cases the availability of land was around 5 acres. However, in few cases the availability was as high as 30 acres. The schools would have 12 class rooms, 4 laboratories, 1 computer room, 1 art and craft room, 1 library and a well developed play ground. As per the tentative implementation schedule, the building would be completed by December, 2010. The projected construction cost was Rs.3.02 crore per school

(iii) The State government was advised to develop an indicative building plan based on broad KV norms and furnish the same to the Ministry.

(iv) GIAC recommended 74 Model Schools in Karnataka at an unit cost of Rs.3.02 crore. A list of these blocks, along with districts, is given in **Annexure III**.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
