

Minutes of the Project Approval Board (PAB) meeting held on 17th March, 2016 for approval of Annual Work Plan & Budget 2016-17 of Madhya Pradesh under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA).

A meeting of the Project Approval Board (PAB) to consider the Annual Work Plan & Budget 2016-17 of RMSA for the State of Madhya Pradesh was held on 17th March, 2016, under the Chairpersonship of Dr. S. C. Khuntia, Secretary (School Education & Literacy).

2. The list of participants who attended the meeting is at **Annexure-I**.
3. Secretary (SE&L) welcomed all the participants. JS (SE.1) gave a detailed overview of the status of implementation, planning and monitoring of RMSA components in Madhya Pradesh. He also highlighted the areas of concern and details of the proposals of the Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B) for the state. A copy of the presentation is at **Annexure-II**.

Discussions were held on the areas of concern and proposals point wise, as follows

3.1 Coverage of Secondary Schools:

3.1.1 Integration of GIS and UDISE data of 121523 schools has been completed. However, Geographic Coordinates of 29818 private schools are awaited. Further, out of 94382 habitations, 74369 (79%) habitations are served by secondary schooling facility, within a distance of 5 Km.

Secretary (SE&L) expressed concern regarding the gap in coverage of secondary schools within 5 km distance. He further requested the State to try and fill the gaps in access and also to make the 484 new schools approved in the year 2015-16, functional on priority basis.

Additional Chief Secretary (Education), Madhya Pradesh assured of expeditious action on these issues.

3.1.2 Proposal for New schools:

The proposal of the State for opening of 800 new schools in 2016-17 was thoroughly discussed and keeping in view the previous approvals, progress of construction work and budget constraints, approval for 230 schools was accorded with the advice that the State would prioritize these based on the actual requirements. ACS(Education), M.P. requested for according in-principle approval for another 200 new schools so that they can plan for the same. The same was given with the strict stipulation that no funds for these 200 schools would be released in 2016-17 and funds for these 200 schools would be released only in the next financial year i.e. 2017-18, subject to budget availability.

3.2 Slow progress of civil works:

3.2.1 Under RMSA, construction of only 859 new schools has been completed, out of the total approved 1428 schools, which shows a 60.15% completion rate. At present, construction has been started in 23 schools whereas work has not started in 546 schools out of which 484 schools are those which were sanctioned in the year 2015-16. Further, 4187 schools were approved for strengthening, out of which 75.72 % works are completed & 10.53% works are in progress.

The Additional Chief Secretary (Education) stated that the 484 new schools sanctioned during financial year 2015-16 could not be taken-up due to request of the state for change of locations for 266 schools for which a supplementary PAB was held in the month of January, 2016, due to which there was delay in release of central & State share funds. He also assured that State PIU (Project Implementation Unit) of RMSA has picked up progress of civil works and is likely to complete all pending works by the end of Dec, 2016. However, due to escalation in cost, the State expressed its inability to take up the works with the State Schedule of Rate (SoR) of earlier year, and offered to surrender the approval already obtained in the years 2009-10 (38 schools), 2010-11 (129 schools) and 2011-12 (63 schools) i.e. total 230 schools (**Annexure-V**), for which work has not been started.

3.3 Girls Hostel:

3.3.1 Out of 201 girls' hostels approved, civil works of 133 have been completed, 51 are in progress and 17 have not yet been started. SPD stated that the work of the remaining hostels is at completion stage and will be completed soon. All 201 girls' hostels are functional with an enrolment of 18498 girls.

3.3.2 Increasing of capacity in the existing Girls Hostel: The Additional Chief Secretary (Education) informed that there is demand of more capacity in the girls' hostel and asked if the existing hostels could be extended from 100 bedded to 150 bedded. The state was informed that the present norms for girls' hostels do not provide for 150 bedded hostels and state may consider increasing the capacity of the hostels from its own funds.

3.4 ICT: 2000 schools were approved for ICT@School scheme in the year 2009-10, but the State has not implemented the scheme in even a single school so far. The state informed that RFQ process has been completed and 12 eligible bidders have qualified for the final stage. The SPD informed that tenders have been finalized and work will be started within a month.

3.5 Educational Indicators:-

- The overall enrollment has increased from Rs. 25.44 lakhs in 2014-15 to Rs. 25.86 lakhs in 2015-16.
- GER has increased from 80.18% in the year 2014-15 to 80.74% in 2015-16
- NER has increased from 42.99% in 2014-15 to 53.40% in 2015-16.
- The Transition rate has increased from 82.20% in 2014-15 to 82.91% in 2015-16.
- The Retention rate has decreased from 83.80% in 2014-15 to 83.41% in 2015-16.
- The drop-out rate has marginally increased from 16.20% in 2014-15 to 16.59% in 2015-16.
- The Gross Access Ratio (GAR) at the State level is 79% in 2015-16, but the Districts of Ashok Nagar (50.41), Datia (52.81), Harda (59.25), Katni (59.25), Seon (52.64), Shahdol (57.09), Shipvpuri (54.23), Tikamgarh (57.15) and Umaria (57.83) are having very low GAR.

Additional Chief Secretary (Education) informed that the State has started an effective child tracking system which may have led to the increase in figures of dropout rate. He further stated that another reason for increase in drop-out at Class VIII level and decrease in enrolment in Class X may be because students opt to appear in Board exam as private candidates. Also, while the number of upper primary schools and students upto Class-VIII has sharply increased due to implementation of RTE, the number of government secondary schools has not correspondingly increased. He also informed that the GPI of the State is 0.97 which is almost near the target of 1.00.

Regarding the districts having low GPI viz. Agar Malwa (0.67), Shivpuri (0.73), Guna (0.75), Ujjain (0.76) and Morena (0.77), the SPD admitted that there is a need for special attention and intervention to address this problem. She attributed low GPI to poor access to schools in rural areas. Parents of these areas do not send their adolescent daughters to the schools, if they are located far away from their village. However, GPI has marginally increased in 2015-16 as the State has taken initiatives like enrolment drive, special coaching etc. Opening of new schools in un-served areas will positively impact the GPI as well. She further informed that due to sustained efforts of the State, the Pass percentage of 10th class has increased from 60.56% in 2014-15 to 64.11% in 2015-16.

Regarding the issue of 04 government schools having zero enrolment, the State informed that these schools are mostly located in urban areas where there is excess of schools. Due to preference of parents to admit their wards in private schools, enrolment in few schools of urban areas has decreased significantly. However, the State would look into this aspect.

3.6 Vacancy of HM:-Out of 1428 approved posts of headmasters sanctioned under RMSA, 413 are in position and 1015 posts are still vacant. Similarly, under the State Government approved 7506 posts of headmasters, 3711 are filled-up and 3795 are lying vacant. Similarly, about 11% posts of teachers are lying vacant in the State.

Secretary (SE&L) asked the state to take immediate action in this regard so as to ensure 100% availability of headmasters (HM) in all secondary schools. State Secretary informed that recruitment process is going on in the State, and existing gap is expected to be filled up soon.

The State further informed that they have now filled up an additional 137 of the approved HM posts by promoting existing teachers as per their recruitment policy. The State has since deposited the proof with regard to promotion of these 137 Headmasters. Keeping this in view, the approval to release the salary component of these 137 Headmasters from the date of their promotion was accorded. Secretary (SE&L) expressed concern regarding the high subject-wise PTR in the State. The State Secretary informed that filling up of teachers' vacancies and rationalization will bring improvement in the subject-wise PTR. He further informed that the State has an online transfer system including providing choice of locations to the teachers.

3.7 Vocational Education:- Under Vocational Education, 50 schools were approved with two trades i.e. IT & ITeS and Security in 2013-14. The State has reported implementation of vocational education in all 50 schools. State further informed that a special survey will be carried out to find out the requirement of jobs in the market. Secretary (SE&L) asked the State to take up trades requiring less infrastructure preferably in the service sector e.g. retail, health care, tourism, IT services etc.

3.8 Other issues:

The Additional Chief Secretary (Education) also informed that one of the reasons for low performance of the students is due to syllabus & curriculum, therefore the State has taken serious steps to convert the curriculum into NCERT curriculum and adopt the same across the secondary schools in the State.

In the State, elementary and secondary schools are being run as separate schools and the State is providing separate UDISE codes to the secondary schools, even where running in the same campus. The state was advised to integrate such schools for better management & optimum utilisation of resources.

4. NAS Performance:

The National Achievement Survey (NAS) conducted by NCERT for Class X indicates that in the State of Madhya Pradesh, percentage of students who have scored marks from 0-50% is 99% in English, 90% in Mathematics, 93% in Science, 81% in Social Science clearly indicating that the quality of education being imparted in the State needs to be improved through appropriate measures.

5. Other Action Points: -

- Aadhar seeding of 55,81,114 (24.80 %) children of the age group of 5 to 18 years is yet to be done by the State
- The State has 2655 schools without electricity.

The Additional Secretary (Education) assured of expeditious action on all these action points.

7. The following points were brought to the notice of Additional Chief Secretary (Education), Madhya Pradesh and requested for corrective action:

- (i) The large backlog of the incomplete Civil Works must be completed through regular monitor.
- (ii) Emphasis should be given to quality learning outcomes through timely recruitment of teachers against vacancies, optimal use of teachers training for science and mathematics where linkages with good resource persons from higher education institutions should be drawn upon. The State shall take findings of National Assessment Survey to identify the gaps in learning level of the students and take corrective measures to address these gaps.
- (iii) The State was advised to ensure implementation of Shaala-Sidhi programme in all schools.
- (iv) The State was advised to collect teachers' data in respect of all teachers deployed in all schools in the State especially with regard to their qualification and training etc.

8. The release of funds to different components of RMSA will be further guided by the following conditions:

- (v) The State Administration will give a written commitment for meeting its share of the converged RMSA Scheme of the budget approved according to prescribed sharing pattern of the schemes. The budget provision may also be communicated to the Ministry immediately after presentation of the State budget.
- (vi) SMDCs should be constituted in all schools and bank accounts may be opened by them to take care of school grant, civil works and other such expenditures.
- (vii) The first installment would be released based on the provisional Utilization Certificate for 2015-16 and subject to full release of proportionate State Share corresponding to Government of India share released during the previous financial year.
- (viii) The second installment would be released only after (a) the proportionate installment of State Share has been released, (b) at least 50% expenditure against available funds has been incurred, (c) audit reports and utilization certificate have been received for funds released in the year 2015-16.

9. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
