**Subject: First Appeal under Right to Information Act, 2005-reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your RTI Appeal Registration no. DOSEL/A/E/20/00103 dated 22.06.2020 wherein you have stated that the information with respect to point E of your RTI Application Registration No. DOSEL/R/E/20/01114 dated 20.05.2020 has not been received.

2. I have got the matter examined. The CPIO in this Department vide letter of even number dated 05.06.2020 has provided the information sought under point A and B of your RTI Application dated 20.05.2020.



The CPIO in this Department had also transferred your RTI Application dated 20.05.2020 to NCERT under Section 6(3) of the RTI Act, 2005 for providing the information sought under point C to E of the Application directly to the Applicant. However, the CPIO in this Department inadvertently mentioned parts C to D instead of parts C to E of your RTI Application while transferring RTI Application dated 20.05.2020 to NCERT. Apparently, the CPIO in NCERT has, therefore, not provided information sought under point E of your RTI Application dated 20.05.2020.

4. The information sought for vide part E of your RTI Application may be available with NCERT. Now, therefore, your RTI Application dated 20.05.2020 has again been transferred to NCERT, duly clarifying the inadvertent mistake, vide this Department's letter of even number dated 06.07.2020 for providing you the information sought for under point E of your RTI Application. A copy of this Department's letter of even number dated 06.07.2020 is enclosed for your information. In case you do not receive the information from the CPIO of NCERT within the prescribed time limit, you may file an Appeal to the prescribed Appellate Authority in NCERT.

5. The RTI Appeal Registration no. DOSEL/A/E/20/00103 dated 22.06.2020 stands disposed off.
