2. The point wise information of your RTI application is as follows:

Sr. No.	Questionaire	Reply
1.	What are the facilities provide by the Indian government to a mentally disabled child.	Under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Samagra Shiksha, there is a norm of Rs.3500 being provided for each CWSN each year. This amount is provided to address various activities under student oriented component and resource support such as tlms, aids & appliances, corrective surgeries, assistive devices, material for resource rooms, special educators etc.
2.	What are the actions can take a guardian for misbehaving with his mentally disabled child.	As the responsibility of implementation lies with the State Govt, therefore the complaint for any misbehaviour should be reported to relevant authorities at Block, District & State level.
3.	In Japan, for education of a single child government runs a train, India is bigger more than Japan, so that in India government can not provides a single teacher for a mentally disable child.	Appointing teachers and special educators is state's prerogative, MHRD provides financial assistance for education sector under the Samgra Shiksha Scheme.
