No.II-SME(B)-61/2014 16550 SME, In pursuance to the provisions contained in Section 38 (1) of the Right of Children to Free & Compulsory Education (RCFCE) Act, 2009, State Government do hereby declare the Panchayat Raj Institutions/ ULBs as the Local Authorities at different levels as required under the provisions of Section 2 (h) of the said Act.,

2. The function of the Local Authorities at different levels shall be broadly as follows:

I. Zillaparishad (Rural Area) & Urban Local Bodies (Urban Area)

To undertake and supervise the implementation of schemes or adopt measures relating to the development of Primary & Upper Primary Education within the district including giving of financial assistance.

II. Panchayat Samiti

To manage, regulate, supervise and spreading of Primary & Upper Primary Education in the block.

III. Gram Panchayat

To undertake, regulate and administer and be responsible for tendering all reasonable assistance to the Samiti in the matter of establishment and maintenance of schools for Primary and Upper primary Education.
